FELLOWSHIP GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

SEASON: Holy Week
SERIES: Palm Sunday
TEXT: Luke 19:28-40
SERMON: Stone Won't Cry

1. **Dividing the Voice:** Share about a time that you used your voice in a way that may have caused division within the church. This may have taken the form of: gossip, critique, grumbling, or embarrassment.
2. **Seeking Unity:** Given that divisive moments usually stem from disagreements, scandals, or other frustrating situations - what *could* you do in such situations to seek unity?
3. **Witness to God's Work:** Can you think of a way that you've seen God at work in and through the Redeemer community? Share what you witnessed.
4. **Crying on Behalf of the Stones:** Who, in the city of Richmond, does not have a voice? Another way to ask this question might be, "what communities or peoples here have a need and are unable to make their need known?" How might you use your voice on their behalf?
5. **A Unified, Humble Witness:** The triumphal entry shows us a picture of the voice of the church as a unified, humble witness. Consider spending some time praying that this would be the voice of Redeemer - both as individuals and as a parish.
